Program Description

In partnership with Staunton City Schools and Waynesboro Public Schools, Project GROWS will be offering seasonal locally-sourced vegetables to students across the Staunton and Waynesboro School Districts once a month. Food Prep Volunteer Description

Volunteers will prepare samples in the cafeteria kitchen at Dixon Educational Center (in Staunton) or at Berkley Glenn (in Waynesboro) as well as organize materials for that week's tasting.
