Contributing to this lovely expression are Crimson Clover, Tulip Poplar, Cherry, Blackberry, Black Locust, Goldenrod, Native Sunflowers, Ironweed, Buckwheat, Brassica, Milkweed, Sunflower, Black and Brown Eyed Susans, Wild Bergamot, Purple Coneflower, Blue Lobelia, Elderberry, Silky Dogwood, Winterberry Holly, Devil's Walking stick and more. Wildflower honeys will differ from year to year, always at the whim of the weather, each expression representing the blooms that flourished in that particular season.
