
Episode 7: Self Guided Activity (Perennials, Annuals, and Biennials)

Vocabulary:

- **Perennial:** A plant whose life cycle extends over many growing seasons and returns each year without being reseeded or replanted
- **Annual:** A plant which completes a life cycle in just one year, or one growing season
- **Biennial:** A plant that requires two years to complete its life cycle
